

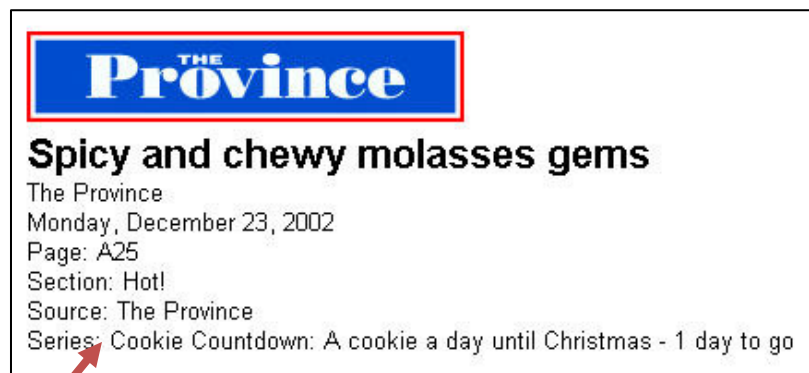
Expert Searching Techniques on FPinfomart.ca: Finding All the Articles in a Series

Perhaps you've just read a great article - and noticed that it was part of a series. You'd like to retrieve all the articles that made up this series.

Use the **series field** to gather all the articles from a series together.

Example: The Vancouver Province ran a series of cookie recipes in the days leading up to Christmas, 2002.

In order to do this, you'll need to view the full text of one of the articles from the series, in order to get the name of a series. The name of the series is **different than the headline of the particular article** you're reading. It is given as part of the additional header information.



This series is called "Cookie Countdown: A cookie a day until Christmas."

Note that we have to see the full text because the headline ("Spicy and chewy molasses gems") is NOT the series name. The series is actually called "Cookie Countdown: A cookie a day until Christmas." We will use this title to search for additional articles in this series.

Use the **Expert Archives** search interface to locate the other members of this series.

The phrase "Cookie Countdown," searched in the **series field** will be enough unique information to locate the articles. The accuracy of the search will be further improved as we know exactly which newspaper to search (the Vancouver Province), and an approximate date range to use (the days leading up until Christmas, 2002).

Use the field search syntax **TERM in FIELD** to specify that your term, "Cookie Countdown" (no quotes required in the search box) should be searched only in the "series" field.

Put your search command in the text area . . .

Cookie Countdown in series

Date Range

in the last 6 months

Dec 1 2002 To Dec 26 2002

SELECT LIBRARY SELECT SOURCES CLEAR

Use the search string **Cookie Countdown in series** for this search. Choose an appropriate date range.

- Prince Rupert Daily News
- Richmond News
- Surrey Now
- Trail Daily Times
- Vancouver Courier
- Vancouver Province
- Vancouver Sun
- Victoria Times Colonist

Since we know exactly which source to search, we'll click the **Select Sources** button. A series of articles always comes from the same newspaper. In this case, we need only search the Vancouver Province.
